



Environmental Programme



Air Emission

The purpose of the Air Emission Management Programme is to provide a tool for managing air emission regulatory compliance and other issues. It will assist Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) coordinators and plant personnel in understanding key air emission issues and will assist plants in achieving company or business unit goals through sound air emission management practices. Completion of this programme will help assure compliance with requirements imposed by regulatory agencies and with our EHS policies.

Water Management

The Water Management Programme will help ensure and maintain compliance with current wastewater regulations affecting this facility. The completed programme will also provide site specific data needed to maintain comprehensive wastewater compliance programme. This programme is a key part of our overall effort to create tools to assist in obtaining 100% compliance with all national, state, provincial and local wastewater discharge requirements. It also serves as a focus for identifying important components required for maintaining compliance.

Waste Management

The Waste Management Programme has two purposes: (1) to assist (EHS) Coordinators and plant personnel understand the key elements of an effective waste management system; and (2) to assist EHS Coordinators and plant personnel achieve company or business-level environmental goals through sound waste management practices. Completion of this programme will help ensure compliance with requirements imposed by regulatory agencies in countries around the world and with our policies.

Chemical Management

The purpose of the Chemical Management Programme is to provide a tool for managing chemical regulatory compliance and other issues. It will assist (EHS) personnel and factory personnel in understanding key chemical management issues and will assist factories in achieving our company goals through sound chemical management practices. Completion of this programme will help assure compliance with regulatory requirements and with our EHS policies.

Industrial Hygiene

Industrial Hygiene (IH) is the practice of controlling employee exposure to potentially harmful agents in the occupational environment. An effective IH programme must protect employees from exposure to agents with immediate, acute health effects, as well as substances that cause diseases long after exposure. An effective IH programme will result in a safer, more productive workplace and decreased company liabilities. To successfully manage IH concerns, facilities need to develop and implement appropriate programmes and procedures.

This programme provides a tool to identify and prevent exposures to potentially harmful agents in the workplace. It should assist (EHS) coordinators and plant personnel to recognise, evaluate, and control occupational risks. Completion of this programme should help ensure compliance with requirements imposed by regulatory agencies as well as with our EHS policy and best practices. The processes and procedures included in this programme are the recommended industrial hygiene practices.

Emergency Preparedness

The purpose of the Emergency Preparedness Programme is to provide a tool to aid the facility in preparing the building, operation and personnel for potential emergency situations. It will guide (EHS) coordinators and plant personnel to evaluate and continually improve their facility's emergency preparedness. Additionally, it will aid facility personnel in the development of a site specific Emergency Response Plan to direct facility actions in an emergency. Completion of this programme will help the facility to comply with country specific regulatory requirements and our EHS policies.
